TOWN OF LEEDS RESOLUTION 2011-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEEDS TOWN COUNCIL TO CREATE AN OFFICIAL DEFINED ADDRESSING GRID, UNIFORMITY IN STREET SIGNAGE, AND CHANGE ADDRESSES NOT CURRENTLY IN CONFORMANCE

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Town of Leeds to provide for the safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has authority to name streets and thoroughfares within the Town, pursuant to Section 10-8-32 of the Utah Code Annotated, and regulate the numbering of houses and lots within the Town, pursuant to Section 10-8-31 of the Utah Code Annotated; and

WHEREAS, the Leeds Planning Commission discussed the issue on April 7, 2010 and May 5, 2010 in regular open and public meetings and voted to unanimously recommend a modified Town wide grid that runs with Main Street and Center Street as the official Town addressing grid in a regular open and public meeting on May 5, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Leeds Town Council discussed the issue on February 2, 2010; May 24, 2010 and May 12, 2010 in regular open and public meetings, and voted to unanimously approve a modified Town wide grid that runs with Main Street and Center Street as the official Town addressing grid in a regular open and public meeting on May 12, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Leeds held two open houses on Saturday, March 19th, 2011 from 10:00 a.m. to Noon, and Friday, and March 25th, 2011 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., to educate the public of safety concerns, the necessary address changes, and to receive public input; and

WHEREAS, the duplication of some addresses, private drives given street names, and street names being used that are not on the Town map have caused confusion in finding homes for emergency fire and medical calls; and

WHEREAS, the post office has also reported home delivery problems for customers and delivery companies because of these identification and addressing issues; and

WHEREAS, the Town has grown, and the Emergency Fire and Medical System (EMS) members know fewer of the residents' names, and therefore, have to more fully rely on the given addresses; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Board President and the Fire Chief, have on reconciling and re-gridding the addresses in a manner that would make the address corrections less intrusive by impacting the fewest amount of residents, yet still provide sufficient clarity for emergency response personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Leeds wishes to create a Town policy to ensure the integrity and consistency of assigning addresses to future homes and developments; and

WHEREAS, a representative of the Utah State Automated Geographic Resource Center (AGRC) approached the Town regarding the discrepancies of Leeds addresses, and worked with the Fire Chief and Town Manager to create a possible addressing solution; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that adoption of a Town wide grid for addressing and uniform policies for identifying addresses within the Town will prevent and resolve duplication of addresses, improve response time by EMS and improve the delivery of public services..

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Leeds, Utah, as follows:

- 1. The Town of Leeds hereby re-affirms and adopts a Town wide addressing grid. The initial point of intersection in the Town wide grid is the junction of Main Street (meridian street) and Center Street (baseline street) and the numbering shall extend thence east, west, north and south. Addresses for a property should be odd numbers on the left side of a route when one is generally traveling away from the center point of the grid, and even numbers on the other side of the route. The "even" and "odd" sides of the route shall be determined by the City Engineer with reference to the prevailing usage in the State of Utah.
- 2. Each property identification number for property within the Town limits must contain:
 - a. A frontage number component which is numerically sequenced and assigned to a structure or parcel along a street according to its relative distance perpendicular to the baseline or meridian axis of the Town wide grid;
 - b. A thoroughfare or street name component consisting of either an alphabetic name or a number name, but not both;
 - c. Thoroughfare type component which modifies the name to distinguish specific locational, functional and physical characteristics of the thoroughfare;
 - d. A unit locator component, which is an alphabetical or numerical code used to identify the high density occupancy units within a structure having one and the same frontage number component.
- 3. Based on the adoption and modification of the Town wide grid, the Town of Leeds hereby changes the identification numbers and/or thoroughfare names of the addresses listed on Exhibit A.
- 4. Thoroughfare and street signs shall prominently display the thoroughfare name and shall include a direction component referencing the compass direction of the sign in relation to the baseline or meridian street (as the case may be) in the lower right corner of the sign.
- 5. Frontage numbers for structures or parcels shall be displayed on the front of the structure closest to the applicable street or thoroughfare.
- 6. Address identification numbers (in conformity with the Town wide grid) shall be issued for future structures when a building permit is issued for such structure by the Town.

- 7. Thoroughfare names and coordinates (in conformity with the Town wide grid) shall be issued for future developments upon final plat approval by the Town.
- 8. The Town of Leeds hereby establishes the changes to become effective January 1, 2012.
- 9. The Town of Leeds will send letters to all those who have address changes for the resident to use as an official document for those needing proof of requested address change.
